Resolution to Amend Title 5, Chapter 2, Fire Protection

Whereas, the Board has previously resolved that the Town will no longer require or issue burning permits, and

Whereas, the Roberts-Warren Fire Association has recommended that the Town amend its Fire Protection Ordinance to comply with current practice;

Now, therefore, it is resolved that ordinance Title 5, Chapter 2, Fire Protection, is hereby amended as follows:

Delete sec. 5-2-10, Outdoor Burning, subsection (i)(1) which formerly read:

“Permit Required. No person shall start or maintain any open burning without a burning permit issued by the Town Board or designee.”


Delete sec. 5-2-10, Outdoor Burning, subsection (i)(3) which formerly read:

“Three-Day Burning Permits. Any person responsible for burning eaves brush clean wood or other vegetative debris under Subsection (f) shall obtain a three-day burning permit from the Town Board or designee before starting the fire. A permit is not required when there is complete snow cover.”


Amend sec. 5-2-10, Outdoor Burning subsection (l)(3) to read as follows:

“Fires will be attended at all times by an adult or responsible family member of the property owner.”

Adopted unanimously by roll call vote on 3/19, 2018.
